The 200 barrels in the cellar are now pegged on constant temperature and good humidity. The crush pad is covered and features big log pillars. The giant winery doors swing freely on big hinges. And the 2005 Cab rocks!

We are currently selling 2006 Chardonnay, 2005 Merlot, 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon, and a limited amount of 2004 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon here at the winery. Tasting notes for all these wines are posted at www.boudreauxcellars.com.

Taste Washington was big for us this year. Gary Vaynerchuck of winelibrary.com fame was present to review our 2004 Reserve. He scored it a "90 Something" after being fairly tough on some other Washington wines that morning.
